

# **CHECK IN INFORMATION FOR YOUR GOJI STAY**

Check in is from 4pm witch check out at 11am, follow the map and directions on your welcome email and be careful not to follow the postcode as this takes you past the farm. You can put Brookhouse Woods, Bromyard into Google maps or follow the link at the bottom. You have a designated parking space in a small car park near the tree cabins, follow the sign for the woods and then turn left towards the tree cabins at the top of the hill, you will see parking spaces for Goji and Hobbit/Whittlers Cabin.

You have use of the Smithers wheelbarrow to help you with your luggage. Please leave him back in the car park at the end of your stay.

Goji is then a short walk across the meadow. If you plan on arriving in the dark bring a torch as there is no lighting, which makes the stars amazing  $\frac{1}{2}$ . The power pack for the lights is just inside the door on the left shelf as you go in. Press the button if they do not come straight on.

## COVID

To help keep everyone safe during Covid times, please wash your hands before entering the cabin and please leave the door open when departing at 11am on check out unless it is pouring with rain. Could you please also do your washing up and leave to air dry and take the top layers only from the sheet, duvet cover and pillow cases and put in the laundry bag provided.

### **LOG BURNER**

You have a log burner to heat Goji and instructions are within on how to use it. If you need any more logs during your stay, you can use the rainbow bag provided to fill up at the log pile which is situated just next to the tree tent opposite your kitchen.

## EXTRAS

Any extras such as food will be in your kitchen on arrival, please check in the fridge and the cupboards for it, and you will be invoiced for them on the day of departure. Charcoal is available at £4.00 per bag

## **OUTDOOR KITCHEN**

The lights for your outdoor kitchen are behind your fridge and the pellets for your pizza oven are in the grey bin and a firelighter from next to the wood burner can be used to start it.

If you have ordered pizza dough it will be left out in the cupboard for you to prove during the day, if you are not going to use it on the first night, pop it into the fridge until the day that you are going to use it. The pizza ovens get very hot and cook the pizzas very quickly, so keep an eye on them ;0) Keep all food inside the fridge or cupboards and lock the doors, the squirrels can be very clever at getting into them around here!

## **OFF GRID**

The outdoor areas are all off grid and rely on solar power, please be mindful and turn off lights when they are not needed.

### **COMPOST LOO**

After you have used the compost loo for a number 2 please throw a large scoop of shavings down the back hole only, please be careful that the sawdust does not go down the front wee hole otherwise it will block up very quickly.

## DOGS.

There are many walks from the farm for you and our furry friends to explore and there are some maps in the tree tent for you. You are free to wander around the farm grounds, but could we please ask that you avoid the hop fields (the fields with the frameworks in them) as hops are very susceptible to infection. We also have animals such as chickens roaming around, so if you could please keep your dogs on a lead when walking around the farm, that would be fantastic. Could you please bag dog poo up and leave outside on the deck when you leave.
